

Most frequently asked questions about the Annual General Meeting

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1. How can I participate in the virtual Annual General Meeting?

As MTU shareholder you can follow the live video and audio broadcast of the entire Annual General Meeting via the AGM portal (weblink: www.mtu.de/hv).

For the AGM portal you will need your shareholder number and your personal access code. You find this information in the cover letter to the invitation to the Annual General Meeting on the first page in the upper right-hand corner.

Please make sure that you have registered for the Annual General Meeting by the deadline of April 28th, 2022 at midnight (CEST).

The live video webcast of the AGM will start at 10:00 am CEST (8.00 am UTC) on May 5, 2022. Shareholders can already dial-in to the link to the live video webcast at approx. 9:30 am CET (7:30 am UTC).

2. What are the minimum technical requirements for my PC or tablet?

The AGM portal is accessible via a PC, tablet, iPad or smartphone that has an appropriate internet connection. All conventional internet browsers (with the exception of the Microsoft Internet Explorer) in their current versions can be used for the internet connection. Flash is not required to follow the live video and audio transmission of the Annual General Meeting. Further explanations can be found in the terms of use for the AGM portal.

3. How can I exercise my voting rights?

For exercising your voting rights you can chose one of the following options:

- you can exercise your voting rights by postal vote,
- you can grant power of attorney and issue instructions to the voting right proxies named by MTU Aero Engines AG, or
- you may appoint a proxy, for instance a bank or an association of shareholders, to vote on your behalf.

In order to exercise their voting rights and further rights in the virtual Annual General Meeting, shareholders must be listed in the Company's share register and their requests to register their shareholding must be received by the Company at the latest by the end of April 28, 2022 (midnight (CEST)).

Shareholders who are listed in the share register can register their shareholding by writing (in German or English) to MTU Aero Engines AG at the following address:

For online registration on the website above, you will need the personal access code that is provided with your shareholders' documentation.

4. On what date do you have to hold MTU Aero Engines AG shares to be entitled to vote?

In order to attend the Annual General Meeting and be entitled to vote, the timely registration for the Annual General Meeting and the number of shares registered in the share register on the day of the Annual General Meeting are relevant. We also refer to the technical record date explained in question 5.

5. Technical Record Date and time frame of registration stop

Please note that, for administrative reasons, no changes in share ownership will be recorded from April 28, 2022 (midnight CET – technical record date) up to the AGM meeting date on May 5, 2022 (midnight CEST). Shares that have been registered for the purposes of the Annual General Meeting are not blocked. After registration, shareholders remain free to dispose of their shares as they wish, even during the above mentioned period in which changes in share ownership are not immediately recorded.

6. Can non-shareholders also follow the Annual General Meeting?

The transmission of the entire virtual Annual General Meeting is reserved for shareholders. However, in light of transparency and as a service, the opening remarks of the Chairman of the Supervisory Board and the speech of the Chief Executive Officer will be broadcasted live at 10:00 am CEST on May 5, 2022 on our website: www.mtu.de/hv. No access code is required. An on-demand version of video webcast of both speeches will be available later that day on our website.

7. Are questions answered in advance and will the answers be made available to shareholders?

Upfront answers to selected questions, which are then no longer be read out at the Annual General Meeting, is not intended.

8. Where do I submit my questions and by when?

Based on Section 1 para (2) No. 3 sentence 2 second half-sentence of the COVID-19 Act, the Executive Board decided that shareholders must submit their questions to the company by electronic means at the latest one day before the Annual General Meeting. The Executive Board will decide in its own dutiful discretion on how to respond to questions.

Submitted questions will be considered under the following conditions:

- Only shareholders duly registered for the Annual General Meeting can submit their questions
- Questions must be submitted electronically via the AGM portal (www.mtu.de/hv) at the latest by Tuesday, May 3, 2022 (midnight (CEST))
- Questions need to be submitted in German language

Questions, which are received too late or by other means of communication (like email, fax or mail) will not be considered, the same applies for questions submitted in other languages than German.

9. Will my name be published when answering questions?

When answering questions during the Annual General Meeting, the name of the questioner will not be mentioned in the answer, unless this has been specifically requested.

10. Where can I view any possible counterproposal?

Shareholders' motions and nominations received in due time will be published without delay together with the name of the relevant shareholder, the reasons given, and any opinion expressed by management, on the Company's website at www.mtu.de/hv.

11. In which language will the Annual General Meeting be held?

The Annual General Meeting will be held in German. For our international shareholders we offer an English translation of the broadcast, which can be accessed via the English version of the website www.mtu.de/hv.

12. What does a shareholder do who has not received an invitation to the Annual General Meeting?

The acquisition of the shares was either after the deadline for dispatch of the invitation letter or the invitation letter could not be delivered by mail.

Please contact the AGM Hotline and ask for a new cover letter and enter the new, correct address if necessary.

If the bank/custodial bank has not had the shareholder entered into the share register, the shareholder must contact his bank/custodial bank.
